#### John "Jock" Nisbet

In the early 1980s, I wandered into an antiques fair at the Bonnie Brae School for Boys in Millington, NJ. The fair promised a display of Scottish antiques and, while largely unaware of my personal Scottish heritage, I was compelled to visit.

From that day forward, I have been swept up into the world of my Scots heritage, and I have been fortunate to be named the Commander of the Name and Arms of Currie. Throughout my near forty-year journey was Jock Nisbet. Jock was the proud proprietor of the Argyle Fish and



Chips Restaurant and the Piper's Cove in Kearny, NJ. A trip to Jock's was the closest thing to Glasgow on this side of the Atlantic where Jock could be found most any Saturday teaching pipe students, assisting bridegrooms seeking a proper wedding kilt and frequently hosting some of the country's best pipers who would stop by to say hello and chew the fat.

As a young man with much yet to learn, I found myself hugely influenced by Jock. I called him one of my "honorary" Scottish uncles who always had time to show me how to fit a kilt and sporran, how to run pipe band competitions, and how to appreciate the difference between good pipers and GREAT pipers.

I dare say anyone involved in the Scots-American world in those pre-Internet shopping years came to know Jock and the Piper's Cove, as it was one of the few shops that could provide all the staples of a proper Highland kit.

Jock was born in Musselburgh, Scotland and came to America in 1962. A gifted piper himself, he served as founder and Pipe Major of the Kearny Caledonian Pipe Band for many years.

Jock passed away earlier this year on October 4 at the age of 82. He was a devoted husband, father, businessman and friend. I can't even begin to estimate the number of weddings, funerals and special occasions that Jock and his pipes played at – he was part of so many lives and memories.

Now we must sadly say goodbye to our departed friend. There's no doubt in my mind that a chorus of pipes played Jock home, and he is now a member of that ancient and illustrious pipe band that plays on in eternity.

Auld acquaintance will not be forgot.



### The Mystical Nativity

The Mystical Nativity is a painting dated c.1500–1501 by the Italian Renaissance master Sandro Botticelli. The Virgin Mary is shown kneeling before the Christ Child in the center, in the presence of the shepherds and Wise Men who are visiting him. At the bottom of the work, three angels embrace three men, while seven devils behind them flee to the underworld.

The painting uses the medieval convention of showing the Virgin Mary and infant Jesus larger both than other figures, and their surroundings; this was certainly done deliberately for effect, as earlier works by Botticelli use correct graphical perspective. The painting depicts a scene of joy and celebration, of earthly and heavenly delight, with angels dancing at the top of the painting. The infant Christ reaches up towards the Virgin Mary, oblivious of his visitors – the Three Kings on the left and the shepherds on the right.

And there are dark premonitions – the helpless child rests on a sheet that evokes the shroud in which his body will one day be wrapped, while the cave in which the scene is set calls to mind his tomb. The Kings on the left bear no gifts, but their own devotion. At the top of the painting twelve angels dressed in the colors of faith, hope and charity dance in a circle holding olive branches, and above them heaven opens in a great golden dome, while at the bottom of the painting three angels embrace three men, seeming to raise them up from the ground. They hold scrolls, which proclaim in Latin, "peace on earth to men of goodwill".


Behind them seven devils flee to the underworld, some impaled on their own weapons. In Renaissance times Last Judgment paintings showed viewers the reckoning of the damned and the saved at the time of Christ's Second Coming. According to art historian Jonathan Nelson, "in echoing this kind of painting The Mystical Nativity is asking us to think not only of Christ's birth but of his return".

The Mystical Nativity is a new composition making its debut at our 2019 concerts. Each year, the Learned Kindred of Currie seeks inspiration for new musical works. Over the years, this body of work marks our continued commitment to the arts and to remaining relevant in the world around us.

Some of our many new works have included, Lament for the Lost, a haunting lament composed on September 11, 2001, Balmoral Snow, composed to commemorate the Diamond Jubilee of HM Queen Elizabeth, II. Lullaby for a Prince marked the birth of HRH Prince George of Cambridge while Sea of Tranquility mourned the passing of Apollo 11 astronaut, Neil Armstrong.

A great many of these works were composed and/or arranged by our musical director, Steve Gibb. Steve's gentle touch can be found through all his works and we are delighted to have him back with us to score our original arrangements for this year's Mystical Nativity, Christmas in George Square and Noel Nouvelet.


